

Position Description: *Project Engineer/Scientist*

The ability to provide effective written communication and utilize spreadsheets and databases is critical as the Project Engineer/Scientist will be responsible for preparing project deliverables. The Project Engineer/Scientist is also expected to develop a technical knowledge base that will support one or more of All4's primary service areas. The Project Engineer/Scientist will also periodically interact with clients on a one-to-one basis and must be able to communicate effectively. Knowledge sharing with other All4 staff will be a responsibility of the Project Engineer/Scientist.

All4 Inc. is a nationally-recognized consulting company shaping environmental responsibility and creating distinction for clients, employees and partners.

The consulting business is an extremely fast-paced, deadline-driven, environment that requires engineers/scientists to be self-motivated, hard-working, and able to work both independently and as part of a team. - Review of state and federal air and environmental regulations.
- Preparation of technical reports in support of environmental permits.
- Development of Excel, Access, and Word documents.
- Analysis of data for air quality modeling support.

Qualifications:

Qualified candidates must possess a Bachelor of Science degree (or higher) from an accredited university and a minimum of 3 years working in the air quality field. Fundamental competencies that are required for All4 Project Engineers/Scientists include:

- Demonstrated experience working with and air quality regulatory and compliance issues.
- Advanced Microsoft Excel, Access, and Word experience.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- High level of motivation for personal growth and goal achievement
- Creative thinking with sound problem solving skills.
- Ability to work independently and in a group environment.
- Strong organizational skills.
